

*The Johnson Hill Land Ethics Studio updated the original campus master plan developed by William J. Johnson in 1967 for the two and four year college on the shores of Lake Michigan.*

A voter-approved bond issue in the late 1990s authorized construction of new and improved laboratory and classroom facilities. In order to ensure this new construction did not overwhelm the existing physical fabric of the campus, the Johnson Hill Land Ethics Studio and AAI Architects conducted in-depth analyses and a series of workshops with faculty and staff to update the master plan and identify new classroom opportunities on campus.

The 100-acre campus is almost fully developed and the updated Master Plan has helped to create an improved image and identity for the college.

The Johnson Hill Land Ethics Studio also provided the detailed planning and design for the improved entrance and sculpture garden. Utilizing a mix of native trees and shrubs, along with woodland plants and perennial flowers, the new design created an entrance that welcomes the visitor and creates a strong sense of identity for the college.
